

Targeted "Activities"/Industries

Firms with project activity in these industries that create and maintain new jobs or make significant financial investment are eligible to apply for up to four tax credits.

- Software Development & New Media
- Scientific R&D

- Back office
- Financial Services
- Music Production
- Entertainment Company
- Life Sciences

Funding Limits

Project must have at least 10% in matching funds of total project cost

Cash and in-kind contributions are allowed

Cities over 100,000 population based on the last census	1 Project	\$2 million
Cities and villages between 40,000 and 99,999 population based on the last census	1 Project	\$1 million
All other municipalities	1 Project	\$500,000

Residential Property	Per Unit Maximum Allowance	
Demolition/Deconstruction	\$20,000	
Rehabilitation/Reconstruction	\$100,000
