

The California Land Recycling Conference will take place Tuesday, June 21 - Thursday, June 23 at the Carson Community Center, 801 E Carson St, Carson, CA 90745. For many this will be the first time convening with a large group of people since before the pandemic. Here's what you can expect at CALRC.

General Covid Rules and Protocols

- Your temperature will be checked upon entry each day. Those with a temperature above normal will be turned away. This temperature check will only happen at the main entrance. You can move freely between the patios, atrium, main hall, etc. without going through a temperature screen.
- Proof of vaccination is not required and we will not be performing vaccination checks.
- Masks are not required but you are welcome to wear one. Masks will be available.
- Social distancing is not required.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at every table and throughout the venue.
- Mics will be wiped down with sanitizer wipes in between each session and between audience questions.

Food Service at the Carson Center

- If you attend all of CALRC, four full meals will be included: Lunch on the 21st, breakfast and lunch on the 22nd, and breakfast on the 23rd. Note that dinner is not provided and lunch is not provided on the 23rd. You will receive a directory to local restaurants in your know-before-you-go email.
- Food service will be traditional buffet style. Masking in the buffet line is not required but masks will be provided to anyone that wants one and buffet attendants will be masked.
- Attendees will serve themselves as they move through the buffet line. Gloves are not required but will be provided.
- Personal water bottles and/or thermoses are recommended.

Parking and Storing Your Personal Belongings

- There is ample free parking at the Carson Community Center. If you stay at the DoubleTree (see info on accommodations on our [event page](#)) you can park there and walk to the Carson Community Center.
- There is no coat or storage room. Please keep your belongings with you, in your car, or in your room.

Accommodations

- There is no designated room block for CALRC. We recommend booking at the [DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel](#) which is walking distance from the Carson Civic Center. Other lodging options in the area include: [Motel 6 Carson](#), the [Miyako Hybrid Hotel](#), [Holiday Inn Los Angeles Gateway - Torrance](#), and the [Bluestem Hotel](#). Ample free parking is available at the Carson Civic Center.
