Elements of Successful Property Owner Engagement:





Voluntary Participation

Engagement is based on individuals or organizations to participate freely, (fostering genuine commitment and collaboration).

Public/Private Partnerships

Collaboration between government entities and private sector organizations to leverage resources, expertise, and innovation for shared goals.





Collaboration efforts lead to significant / locally-positive changes such as property reactivation, improved economic opportunity, or lasting impacts on the community.



Very few brownfield projects focus on: (A) Orphan/abandoned sites and/or (B) Tax delinquency/foreclosure.

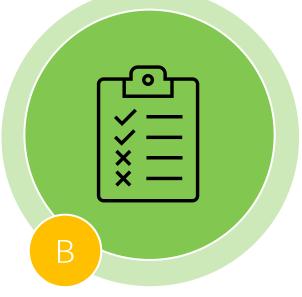


Successful Brownfield Projects Have...



Motivated/Engaged Property Owner(s) & Other Key Stakeholders





Feasible Cleanup & Reuse Plans



Avoid focusing challenging sites with unengaged stakeholders that lack feasible plans/opportunities



Pitfalls to Avoid for Site Prioritization





Funding "Science Experiments" (choose verified processes / methods)



Utilizing funding as an **Enforcement Tool** (use as an incentive)



"Arm Twisting" for Participation (invite willing participants)



Projects with Risk >> Reward (emphasis untapped opportunity)



Best Practices for Property Owner Engagement



Feasible Cleanup/Reuse Plans & Strategies



Develop Accurate Costs & Schedules



Leverage Momentum



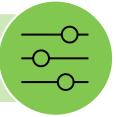
