### **Brownfield Properties Revitalization Fund (BPRF)**

#### Business Oregon

Forgivable loans for the purpose of reimbursing private owners or operators for the eligible costs incurred in the completion of removal or remedial actions on properties that are brownfields.

### **Oregon Brownfields Redevelopment Fund**

#### Business Oregon

A direct loan and grant financing program to assist property owners to conduct environmental actions and assessment through cleanup on brownfields.

### **ColPac Brownfield Revolving Loan**

#### Columbia Pacific Economic Development District

Funded by an EPA RLF Grant, a low-to-no interest loan financing option for cleanup projects on properties impacted by the existence of hazardous substances and for which cleanup is necessary in order for development or redevelopment to occur. Programmatic focus on ColPac's service area.

### **Oregon Coalition Brownfields Cleanup Fund**

#### Business Oregon

Business Oregon manages a brownfields cleanup fund through an EPA RLF grant that has similar programmatic terms and eligibility to ColPac's Brownfield Revolving Loan. Available statewide.

#### DEQ Oregon

Funded by the EPA, DEQ performs Site-Specific Assessments designed to promote redevelopment or property transfer.

## EPA GRANTS\*

### **EPA Multipurpose Grant**

Appropriate for communities that have identified through community engagement efforts a discrete area with one or more brownfield sites. Applicants can apply for up to \$1M – some cost-share may be required.

### **EPA Community Wide Assessment Grant**

Provide up to \$500K for brownfield inventories, planning, environmental assessments and community outreach.

### **EPA Cleanup Grant**

Provide funding to carry out cleanup activities at brownfield sites **owned** by the applicant. Some cost-share may be required.

## TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

### **Technical Assistance to Brownfields (TAB)**

#### Center for Creative Land Recycling

Assist specific regions with TA and training to communities and other stakeholders on brownfield issues, such as: reviewing grant applications; performing site inventories; reviewing historical information; cleanup and redevelopment planning; and more. Available through September 2028.

### **EPA Targeted Brownfield Assessment (TBA) Program**

A targeted brownfields assessment (TBA) is conducted by an EPA contractor on behalf of an eligible entity. Services include site assessments, cleanup options and cost estimates, and community outreach. Eligible applicants include public entities and nonprofits. Available on a rolling basis.

### **Land Revitalization Technical Assistance (LRTA)**

TA designed to help communities identify practical, safe reuse options and approaches that support local goals. Contractor-provided TA gives communities direct access to brownfields site planning, design and finance experts. Eligible applicants include public entities and nonprofits. Available as resources allow.
